

## Attaching Arabic Alphabet I

**The Friendly Letters** do not change much when written in different positions of the word. They just make room for other letters to connect before and after except for ت which has two more shapes for the taa marbota (التاء المربوطة) that signifies in most cases a feminine word. These two extra forms are ة and ة as explained in the table below (examples: فتاة - زوجة).
