## Numbers from 3 to 10

1-If <u>the number</u> ends in 5 it must be pronounced.

2-The number should be opposite gender to the counted.

3-The case ending of <u>the</u> <u>number</u> depends on its position in the sentence.

ثمانية أعوام
تسع سنوات / سنين
عشرة أقلام

1-The counted should be in plural.

2-The counted must be in the genitive case ending.

3-Gender of <u>the counted</u> must be detected from its singular form.

4-The number can never start with lor ends in Tanween.

4-The counted ends with Tanween Kasraa if it is not Sound Masculine Plural.
