

Site is vacant

This building is situated at St. Mellons Business Park. It is a prominent, detached, two-storey headquarters-style office building located at the entrance of the park in Cardiff.

Offering 22,500 sq ft of mainly open-plan space, it features an attractive landscaped internal courtyard, raised floors, suspended ceilings, air-conditioning, recessed lighting, kitchen and breakout areas, and 70 parking spaces.

Ground Floor: Community & Services

Wing G1: Exhibition and Events

Entrance, reception, discover Islam and event space

Wing G2: Community & Activity Centre

Multipurpose hall for youth activities, scouting, sports sessions, workshops, and community events (overflow prayer space during peak times)

Wing G3: Events & Conference Facilities

Meeting rooms and conference spaces for training, seminars, national gatherings, and community development

Wing G4: Social & Hospitality

Café, restaurant/canteen, and social seating areas supporting connection and sustainability

First Floor: Worship, Education & Enterprise

Wing F1: Masjid & Prayer Facilities

Dedicated prayer space for brothers and sisters, designed for worship, reflection, and tranquility

Wing F2: Education Centre

Nursery, Classrooms, teaching spaces, Qur'an/Arabic learning provision, and study circles

Wing F3: Library & Learning Resources

Islamic and Arabic literature, quiet study areas, research resources, and community learning support

Wing F4: Enterprise & Office Spaces

Offices, hot desks, dedicated workspaces, and facilities enabling Muslim organisations across Wales to collaborate

Reception

Main entrance including two lifts and reception area in which visitors are welcomed. Site security office

Discovery Area

Exhibition space to discover Islam and learn more about the centre provision

Event Space

Large conference/meeting rooms

Restaurant and Canteen

Providing lunch options for visitors of the centre

Wellness Centre

Separate male and female gym facilities

Cafe

Leased cafe space to provide a relaxed meeting and social area


Activity Centre

Comprising of:

- Multipurpose halls that can be used for sports and youth activities, including Scouts
- Hall can be hired out for events and private functions
- During busy periods can be used as extra prayer space

Masjid

To be used for prayers only, accommodating both a brothers and sisters space. Designed to allow people to gather and pray and also offer spaces for relaxation and contemplation.

Enterprise Centre

Office space for a variety of purposes e.g. offices for lease, hot desks and dedicated office space.

Education Centre

Classrooms and offices, used for teaching Quran, Arabic and Islamic Studies to include Tajweed and Ijazah. Weekly study circles. Library facility with Islamic and Arabic literature.
